Offence Categorized

- Sin (against you) Eccl. 10:4; 2 Cor. 11:7
- A Stumbling 1 Sam. 25:31; Is. 8:14
- A falling away Rom. 4:25; 5:15-20 (paraptoma)
- A stumbling block Rom. 14:20 (proskomma); 2 Cor. 6:3 (proskope); Mt. 16:23; 18:7; Lk. 17:1; Rom. 9:33; 16:17; Gal. 5:11; 1Pet. 2:8 (skandalon)

A Stumbling

Something that could be a barrier toward an end result (David, Nabal, Abigail)
The Lord Almighty was to be the offense for both houses of Israel (Is. 8:14)

Sin

Cor. 11:7, → Mt. 18:15 (The offended brother)
But sin is against God 1 John 3:4

A falling away

A false step and an offense toward God.

We can see that Satan trapped Adam, but the key word for offense associated with trap is skandalon, which also is a stumbling block.
