## **Isaiah 52:13-15:**

Isaiah 53:13:

- General Reference to Messiah’s Future Successful Mission
- Resurrection – He Will Be Exalted
- Ascension – He Will Be Lifted Up
- Glorification and Session – He Will Be Very High

Isaiah 52:14: Trials and Cross Work

- Disfigured during His Trials
- Beaten Condition on the Cross

Isaiah 52:15: Second Coming {to Earth}

## **Isaiah 53:1-12:**

Isaiah 53:1 – Quoted in John 12:38 = Unbelief Even with Christ’s Miracles

- Quoted in Romans 10:16 = Unbelief in Preaching of the Gospel

Isaiah 53:2 – Birth – Not Physical Appearance cf. Psalm 45:2

Isaiah 53:3 – Earthly Ministry – Despised and Rejected

Isaiah 53:4 – Earthly Ministry

- Seen as Smitten by God
- Commentary in Matthew 8:14-17

Quoted as Fulfilled in Matthew 8:17

Isaiah 53:5 – Cross Work

- He Was Wounded for Our Transgressions = Only Israel
- He Was Crushed for Our Perversity
- With His Stripes We Are Healed – God the Father Laying on Stripes

Allusion in 1 Peter 2:24

Isaiah 53:6 – Cross Work – Alluded to in 1 Peter 2:25

Perversity Laid on Him – Beaten with Our Perversities

Isaiah 53:7 – Judgment Hall – Illegal Trials – Verses 7, 8 – Quoted in Acts 8:32, 33

Ethiopian Eunuch Reading Here When Philip Arrived.

– He Did Not Open His Mouth

Fulfilled un Matt. 26:63; 27:12-14; Mk. 15:2-5

Isaiah 53:8 – Judgment Hall – In Restraint and Under Judgment

Cross Work

– Cut Off from the Land of the Living

– Death for the Transgression of My People

Isaiah 53:9 – Burial – Quoted in 1 Peter 2:22

Note Plural “Deaths” (Hebrew)

Isaiah 53:10 – Cross Work

(1) Father Pleased

(2) Offered His Soul for a Trespass Offering

(3) Father Satisfied

Isaiah 53:11 – Cross Work

(1) Father Satisfied

(2) Travail of Soul = Immaterial – **Spiritual** Not Physical  
– Different נֶפֶשׁ (*nephesh*) Meaning than in Verse 10

(3) Cause to Justify the **Many** (More Than Jews)

(4) He Will Bear [Vicariously] Their Perversities

Isaiah 53:12 – Resurrection

(1) Divide with Many

(2) Divide Spoil with the Victorious

Cross Work

(1) Poured Out His Soul Unto Death – Spiritual Death

(2) Numbered . . . Transgressors – With Two Thieves

Quoted in Mark 15:28 and Luke 22:37

(3) Bare the Sin Nature of **Many** (anarthrous) and Intercedes for Transgressors
